

Tee-Ball Rules and Regulations

- 1. The ball shall not be pitched, but hit off a batting tee located one foot in back of the home plate and in line of the plate.
- 2. The pitcher will ask the batter "Are you ready?"
- 3. The batter may not swing at the ball until the pitcher has made the pitching motion from the pitcher's plate.
- 4. Batters are not permitted to bunt or swing easy at the ball.
- 5. Players are not permitted to steal or lead off bases.
- 6. An infield hit is a single.
- 7. There is no infield fly rule.
- 8. Overthrow: Once the ball is in the infield, the runner will stop at the base toward which he/she is traveling.
- 9. All decisions of the umpire (a coach) are considered final.
- 10. Scores are not kept.
- 11. No 10-run rule shall be in effect.
- 12. Batting the entire line up shall constitute a ½ inning.
- 13. Defense is allowed.
- 14. All players will take the field. Each team may have up to seven (7) infield players. The remaining team members shall play in the outfield.
- 15. Outfielders must play no closer than 10 feet past the bases.
- 16. Bench courtesy must be stressed for safety reasons.
- 17. Only batter and on deck batter will be off the bench.
- 18. All games are 1 hour in length.
- 19. Games will be played on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- 20. Players should not be 7 years old before May 1st.
- 21. Pitcher's mound is 35 feet; bases are 60 feet.
- 22. A 10 foot line will be marked on the field; to be put in play, a ball must be hit at least 10 feet from home plate.
- 23. The ball cannot be rolled to the base for a put out.
- 24. Teams shall clean the field and spectator area of any garbage or debris prior to vacating the area.
