



# 2020 FISHING PERMIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

No person shall take or attempt to take any fish from any body of water located on Park District property unless such person is in possession of a current State of Illinois fishing license **and** a permit issued by Hollis Park District. ID required for proof of residency and Senior/Veteran permits.

***Due to COVID 19 restrictions we are adhering to the CDC Social & Physical Distancing guidelines***

## **FEES:**

Residents:	Free to persons residing in Hollis Park District
Non Resident Adult/Couple	\$65.00/\$105.00
Non Resident Senior/Veteran	\$45.00 (55 yrs. and older; Veterans or IL Class 2 Disability)
Non Resident Senior/Veteran Couple	\$65.00 (one person 55 yrs. and older)

## **NO GUEST PASSES AVAILABLE until after COVID 19 Restrictions END & Office Reopens**

No person shall transfer or loan a fishing permit to another person. Such transferal or loan shall result in confiscation of the fishing permit and may warrant citation.

No person in possession of a valid fishing permit shall host, as guest, a person to fish on any body of water located on Park District property until such guest is in possession of a '**HPD Guest Pass**' fishing permit. Such hosting of unauthorized guest may result in citation to the hosting party.


**Persons possessing such a permit may fish in Reed City Lake subject to the following restrictions:**

- 1. NO MINNOWS shall be used as bait.**
- 2. No fishing shall be done other than with a pole and line.**
- 3. Maximum of two poles per fisherman.**
- 4. Limits Of Fish Taken In 1 Calendar Day By One Person**

a. Largemouth Bass	16 inches or longer	<b>Limit 2</b>
b. Sunfish	(with no more than <b>15 sunfish</b> 6 inches or longer)	<b>Limit 25</b>
c. Walleye	must be 18 inches or longer	<b>Limit 1</b>
d. Catfish	must be 14 inches or longer	<b>Limit 3</b>
e. Bullhead or Crappies		<b>No Limit</b>
- 5. No Grass Carp or Frogs shall be taken at any time.**
- 6. No person shall take or attempt to take any fish at any time other than during the following times:**
  - a. Friday, Saturday, Sunday between 6:00am – Dusk from May 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>.**
  - b. Holidays: Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July and Labor Day.**
  - c. Wednesdays between 6:00am – Dusk for those with a *Senior Permit* and 1 guest under the age of 55 with a HPD permit or guest pass.**
  - d. Children under the age of 16 may fish without a permit and must be accompanied by an Adult who has an HPD fishing permit.**
  - e. Ice Fishing between 7:00am – 5:00pm on Saturday and Sundays during November-March weather permitting and provided the park has posted as open for ice fishing.**
- 7. No Alcoholic Beverages are allowed.**
- 8. Trolling Motors only.**
- 9. No Swimming or Wading.**
- 10. Permits and guest passes may be purchased at the Hollis Recreation Center during staffed hours.**

# Tips for Physical Distancing In Parks

**Know what 6 feet looks like.** Lay measuring tape on the ground. It's the distance of a surfboard, long yoga mat or adult bike.



**Do not use playgrounds or other frequently touched surfaces.**

**Go by yourself or those you live with.**
